In Memoriam Samuel Duff McGlone '58, R.I.P.



Sam McGlone, age 79, died on April 28, 2019 while wintering in Venice, Florida. He was also a resident of Edina, Minnesota. Class of '58 thoughts and prayers for God's grace are with his beloved family, son Michael (Minneapolis) and daughters Molly (Denver) and Michelle (Denver). Sam was a devoted grandfather to six grandchildren. Prior to his death Sam was able to enjoy visits with several of his Loyola Academy classmates.

Sam McGlone R.I.P. Sam, commuting from Evanston, was a proud graduate of the Academy (English Course) in 1958. While there, he joined the Swimming Team as a Freshman, was a class officer in Junior year, and experimented with running Track as a Junior. He was a terrific classmate and a member of the esteemed 4F group of scholars. He graduated from Xavier University, Cincinnati, in 1962. A highly decorated US Army combat helicopter pilot in Vietnam, he was awarded the Silver Star for combat valor, the Army Air Medal with V device for Valor, and other medals. After his military service, McGlone joined Northwest Orient Airlines as a pilot and retired as a Captain from the Minneapolis-St. Paul, Minnesota airline.
